

COMPUTER/INTERNET AGREEMENT

Acceptable Use/Behavior on the Network.

A student using the Internet agrees to the following:

- Access to the Internet is for educational use and not for personal/recreational use.
- Users of the Internet are responsible for their actions and activity. Unacceptable uses of the Internet will result in the suspension or revoking of this privilege. Such uses may be detected by school personnel supervising the use of equipment or by the personnel reviewing electronically the activity of any student.
- Students must use only a fair share of the Internet time.
- Students who download files or save information must do so on their own discs.

Other illegal and/or unacceptable uses such as, but not limited to the following are not permitted:

- violating copyrights and other intellectual property rights (e.g., copying licensed programs, games, etc.)
- degrading or disrupting equipment or system performance
- vandalizing or copying the data of another user
- gaining unauthorized access to resources
- invading the privacy of individuals
- posting anonymous messages
- posting personal communications without the author's consent
- using the network for financial or commercial gain
- using Instant Messenger
- playing games
- using inappropriate language on computers
- chat rooms
